Definition: A <u>solution</u> to an equation is a value (or values) which, when substituted for the variable (or variables) makes the equation true.

Definition: A <u>solution</u> to an equation is a value (or values) which, when substituted for the variable (or variables) makes the equation true.

Example: x = 3 is a solution to the equation 2x - 1 = 5 because

$$2 \cdot 3 - 1 = 5$$
